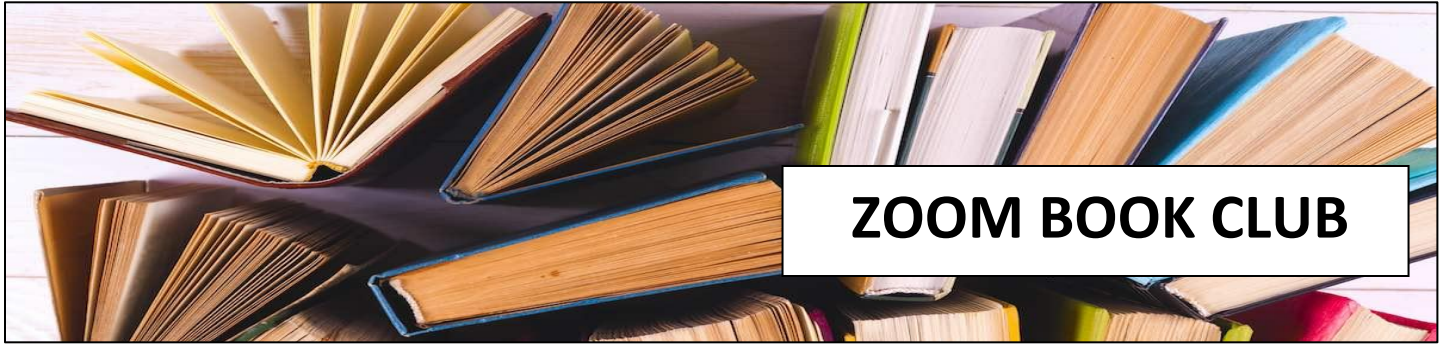

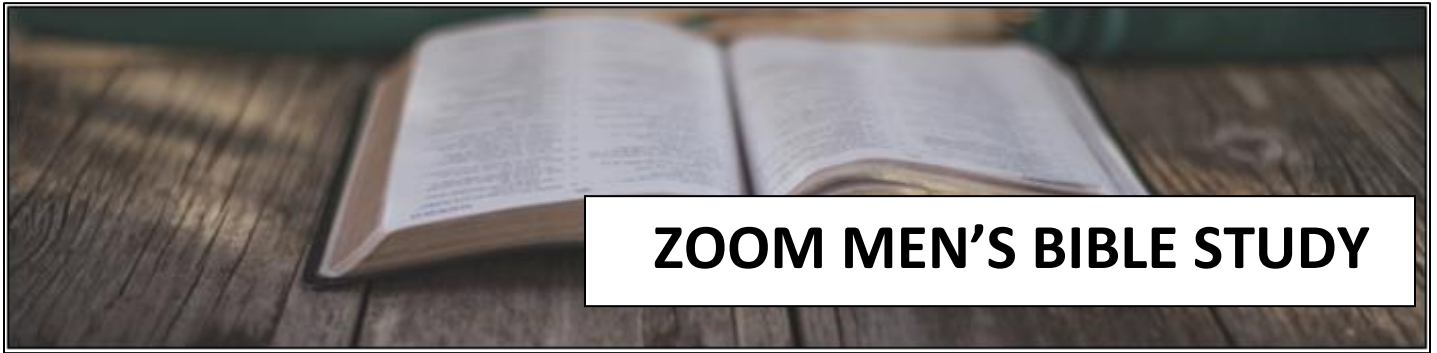


## ZOOM LUNCH WITH PASTOR JULIE
